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Preface

Keep in mind the following items of explanation when reviewing information contained in the *Profile of Students Enrolled at The University of Iowa*.

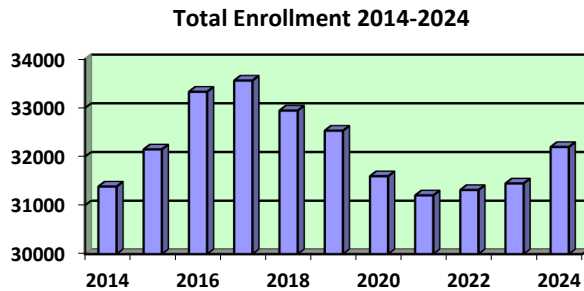
1. The University of Iowa data found in this report is based on the census date snapshot which occurs at the end of the tenth day of the semester. This is in alignment with the reporting dates of the other Regents' institutions.
2. Beginning Fall 2014, most breakdowns "by college" are now available by curricular college and program college. Curricular college is defined as the managing unit responsible for the curriculum and teaching of the programs of study while program college is defined as the managing unit responsible for the awarding of degree or credentials upon successful completion of the program of study.
3. Beginning Spring 2016, The University of Iowa began its Inclusive Student Records initiative. All reports contained in the profile previously done "by gender" are now reported "by sex". Any comparison reports were changed to reflect the new categories. For more details regarding the Inclusive Student terminology, please see the Resources for Trans Communities and their Allies website - <https://uiowa.edu/ui-trans-resources/identity-terminology>."
4. Beginning Fall 2017, the Tippie School of Management was renamed Graduate Management Programs.
5. Beginning Fall 2017, students exclusively enrolled in Iowa Intensive English Program (IIEP) courses, previously included in the undergraduate counts, are no longer being included in any enrollment totals. Note, data regarding the number of students participating in the Intensive English Program can be found in those tables which specifically break out programs of study.
6. Effective Fall 2018, the Division of Continuing Education (DCE) is no longer an active curricular college. It has become Distance and Online Education (DOE) and is a division under the University College.
7. Effective Fall 2021, withdrawn students are no longer being included in any enrollment totals. Any comparison reports were changed to reflect the new counting method.
8. Effective Fall 2023, Big Ten Academic Alliance (BTAA) CourseShare Program students whose home institution is not The University of Iowa, as identified by the BTAA program qualifier, are not being included in any enrollment tables.
9. Effective Spring 2024, the Iowa Intensive English Program (IIEP) non-degree preparatory program of study has ended and all IIEP subject courses have been discontinued.
10. Effective Summer 2024, Graduate Management Programs, a division under the Tippie College of Business, was renamed Tippie Professional Programs.

Facts at a Glance

Enrollment

Total enrollment at the University of Iowa for the first semester of academic year 2024-2025 is 32,199, an increase from the previous year with 31,452.



The student body is composed of:

- ◆ 22,738 undergraduate students,
- ◆ 6,164 graduate students,
- ◆ 1,877 professional students and
- ◆ 1,420 post-graduate training students.

(Medical residents, fellows, and post-doctoral students are considered to be post-graduate training students. Students seeking a Medical Doctor (MD), Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS), Juris Doctor (JD) or Pharmacy Doctor (PHR) degree are considered professional).

The **mean age** of the total student body is 23.1. It is:

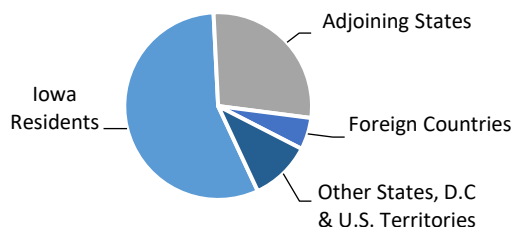
- ◆ 20.4 for undergraduate students
- ◆ 30.3 for graduate students
- ◆ 25.0 for professional students
- ◆ 32.4 for post-graduate students

88.6% of University of Iowa students are enrolled **full-time**. 54.8% of the students are **female**.

The **largest program college** is Liberal Arts and Sciences, enrolling 46.2% of the total student body.

Iowa residents comprise 56.1% of the total enrollment; 27.8% of the total reside in adjoining states; and 5.5% reside in foreign countries. The remaining 10.5% come from the 43 other states, the District of Columbia and U.S. territories. Students come to the University from every Iowa county, all 50 states, four U.S. territories, and 101 foreign countries.

Percent of Total Enrollment

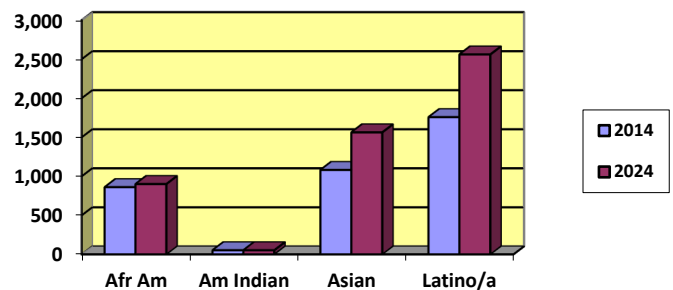


International student enrollment is 1,786 compared to 1,815 in Fall 2023 (5.5% of the total student enrollment).

New Students

24.7% of all students on the campus this fall are new to the University. The **total number of entering first year students** increased by 144 students to 5,208 compared to 5,064 in Fall 2023. The **number of transfer students** new to the University increased by 99 students to 2,731 compared to 2,632 in Fall 2023.

49.8% of the new transfer students are Iowa residents, representing 86 Iowa counties. Transfer students also came from 48 other states, the District of Columbia, 1 U.S. territory and 51 foreign countries.

54.0% of the entering first year students are Iowa residents representing 92 Iowa counties. First year students also came from 42 other states, 2 U.S. territories and 25 foreign countries.

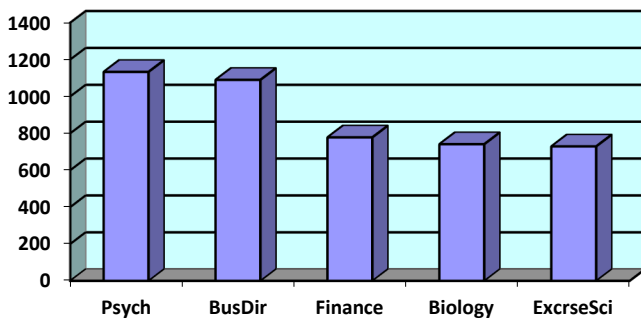

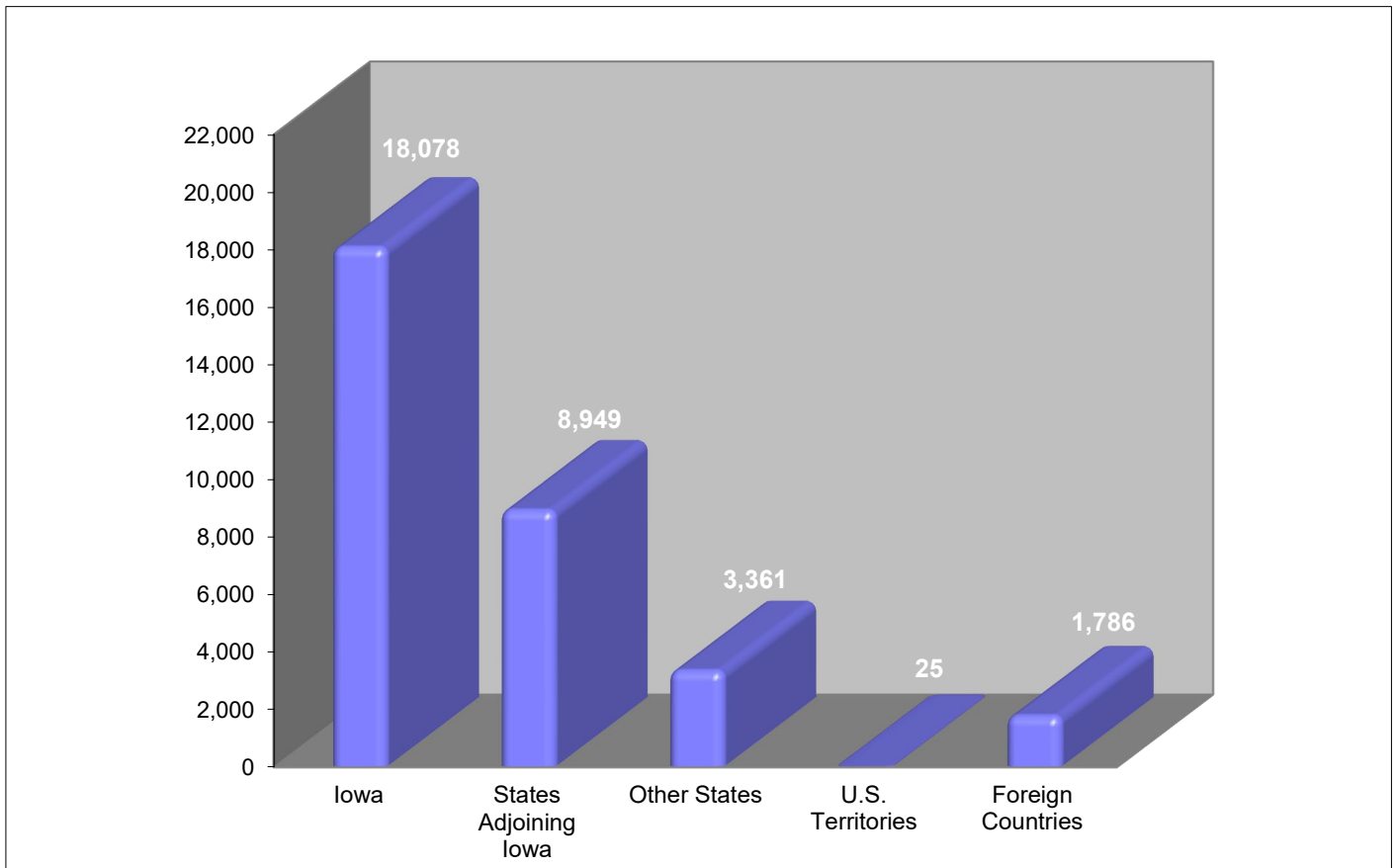

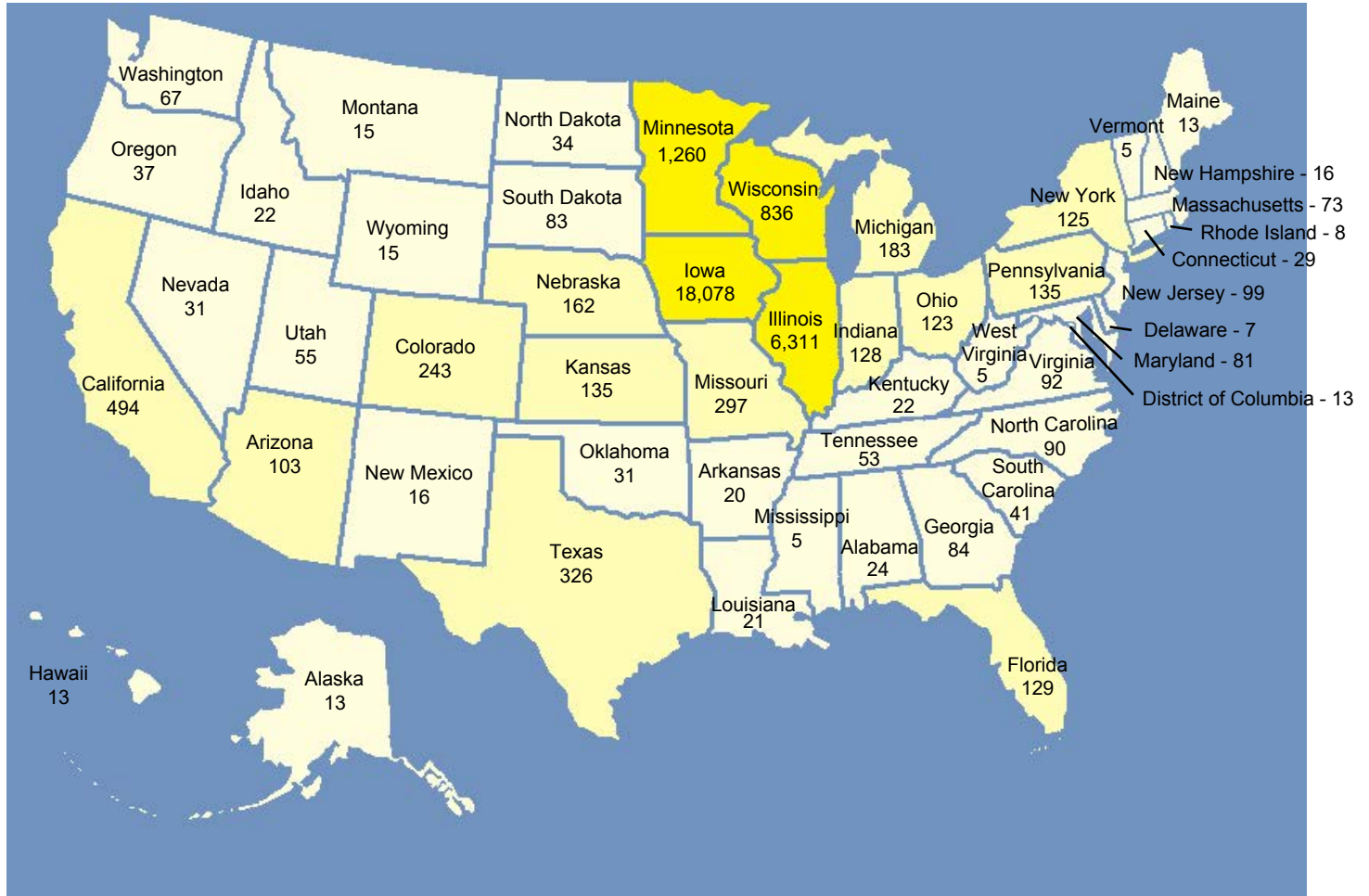

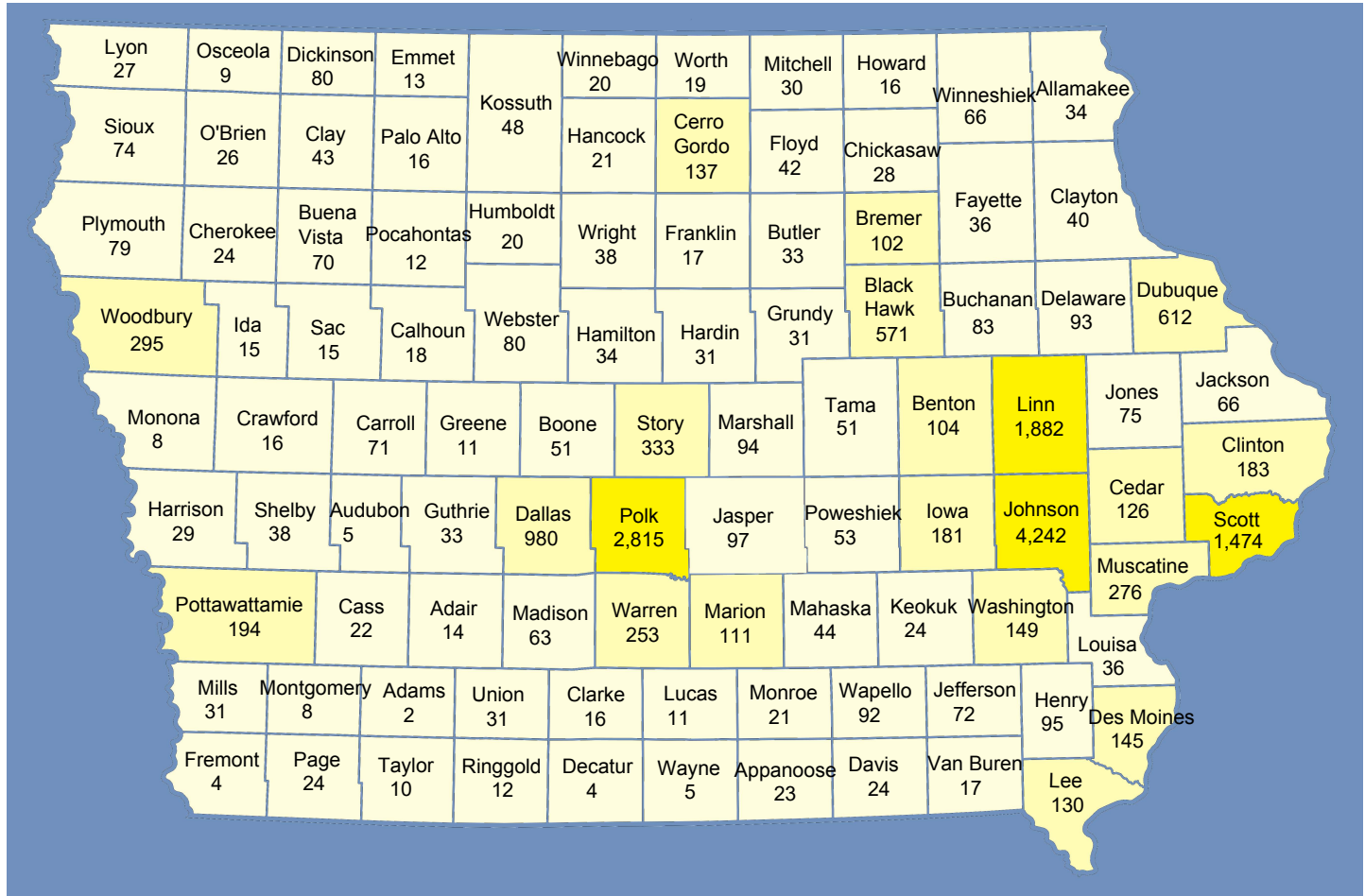
**Geographic Distribution of U.S. Students by State

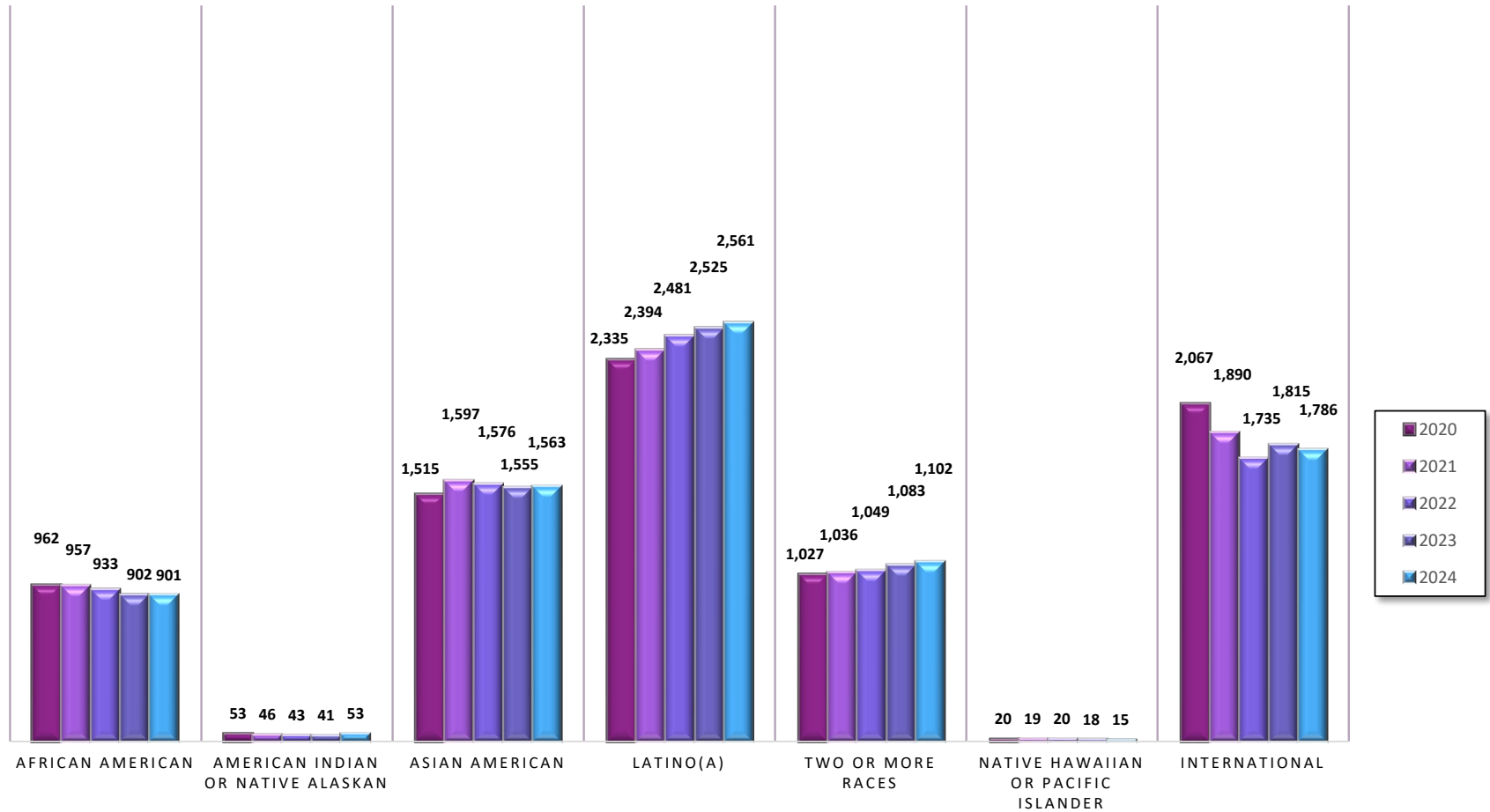
