Your **notarized** tax-filing intention statement (executed in Iowa) declaring in what state you intend to file this year's and future state resident income tax returns. Your statement should be similar to this: *I, Chris Smith of 123 Clinton Street, Apt. #1 in Iowa City, plan to file my (specify the current year in numbers, i.e. 2018) and future state resident income tax returns in the State of Iowa.*" Most Iowa banks and local financial institutions offer notary public service to their customers.

A copy of your parents' <u>state</u> income tax return(s) for the year during which your 12-qualifying months began. If the names of all dependents are not specified, please also submit the first page of their Federal/U.S. tax return.

Your parents' **notarized** tax filing intention statement(s) declaring they will not claim you as a dependent on their current year <u>and future</u> state resident income tax returns (specify year in numbers, i.e. 2018 and name state). This statement must include their names, address(es), their relationship to you, your full name and Iowa address. Each parent must sign the statement before a notary and the document must be notarized.

<u>All</u> of your pay statements for the 12 months indicated for your qualifying year <u>in date order and accompanying 3-</u>column spreadsheet showing pay period dates, employer name and number of hours worked during each pay period:

- Students submitting a **Fall 2018** application should provide all pay statements for all work completed between August 20, 2017 and June 30, 2018, showing hours worked/payment through the last day of each month. Remaining pay statements through August 18, 2018 will be required later. Applications are due in early July, after you have your pay statement for hours worked through June 30, 2018.
- Students submitting a **Spring 2019** application should provide all pay statements for all work completed between January 13, 2018 and October 31, 2018, showing hours worked/payment through the last day of each month. Remaining pay statements through January 12, 2019 will be required later. Applications are due in early November, after you have your pay statement for hours worked through October 31, 2018.
- Students submitting a **Summer 2019** application should provide all pay statements for all work completed between May 13, 2018 and April 30, 2019, showing hours worked/payment through the last day of each month. Remaining pay statements through May 12, 2019 will be required later. Applications are due in early May, after you have your pay statement for hours worked through April 30, 2019.
